

## Introducing Renewable Energy to HQ, Stores and Distribution Centers

From April 2024, Kakuyasu Group Co., Ltd. (“the Company”) began introducing renewable energy at fourteen (14) of its sites including the headquarters building, distribution centers and stores.

This initiative will enable annual reductions of approximately 900t-CO<sub>2</sub> from the purchase of renewable energy-derived power supplied by Mitsuuroko Green Energy Co.,Ltd.(Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo). Going forward, the Company will continue to phase in the introduction of renewable energy-derived power sources in an effort to further reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.

### Introducing renewable energy sources

Applicable sites: Fourteen (14) sites in Tokyo, Saitama and Kanagawa prefectures

- Headquarters: No.2 Building, No.3 Building
- Distribution Centers: Chuo Center, Johoku Center, Saitama Center, Komone Center
- Small Warehouse: Meguro
- Stores: Miyamae Store, Machiya Store, Hodogaya Store, Azamino Store, Hiratsuka Store, Shonan Lifetown Store, Higashi Yamato Store

Expected annual reduction in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions: Approx. 900t-CO<sub>2</sub>.
